



2017 FREEMAN PINOT NOIR GLORIA ESTATE (GREEN VALLEY)

Robert Parker Wine Advocate Score: 93

Pale to medium ruby, the 2017 Pinot Noir Gloria Estate is scented of raspberry preserves, pomegranate, blueberry hints, tangerine peel, cranberries and crushed red cherries with earthy and spicy touches. It's Light to medium-bodied with great intensity and layers in the mouth, framed by lightly chalky tannins and great freshness, finishing very long. Drink date: 2020-2030.



2017 FREEMAN PINOT NOIR YU-KI ESTATE (SONOMA COAST)

Robert Parker Wine Advocate Score: 93

The 2017 Pinot Noir Yu-ki Estate comes from the far western Sonoma Coast, five miles from the Pacific and at 1,000 feet of elevation. The nose gives stewed black tea leaves, warm blackberries, nori, bergamot, rhubarb and potpourri with dried rose petal and warm earth hints. Light to medium-bodied, it has an intense, savory fruit core with lightly chalky tannins and integrated freshness, finishing long and layered. Drink date: 2020-2030.



2017 FREEMAN PINOT NOIR AKIKO'S CUVEE (SONOMA COAST)

Robert Parker Wine Advocate Score: 92

Pale to medium ruby, the 2017 Pinot Noir Akiko's Cuvée is scented of red and black cherries, dried herbs, dusty earth, blackberries, stewed black tea leaves and potpourri with woodsmoke and bergamot emerging over time. Light to medium-bodied with slowly evolving fruits and spices, it's framed by grainy tannins and seamless freshness, finishing long and spicy. Drink date: 2019-2027.



2017 FREEMAN PINOT NOIR KR RANCH (SONOMA COAST)

Robert Parker Wine Advocate Score: 92

This vineyard designate was previously bottled as "Keefer Ranch" but will henceforth be known as "KR Ranch," as the Dutton family took over management of the property in 2016. Pale to medium ruby, the 2017 Pinot Noir KR Ranch features wild blackberries and black cherries on the nose with a core of cranberry, pomegranate and rhubarb plus accents of raspberry jam, orange oil, black tea leaves and warm earth. Light to medium-bodied, it has a great core of spicy fruits, a soft frame of grainy tannins and juicy freshness, finishing spicy. Drink date: 2019-2027.



2017 FREEMAN CHARDONNAY HAWK HILL VINEYARD (SONOMA COAST)

Robert Parker Wine Advocate Score: 91

The 2017 Chardonnay Hawk Hill Vineyard opens with notes of spring honey, dried acacia and baby's breath flowers with crushed stone, dried apple skin and oodles of white peach fruit at the core. Light to medium-bodied, it's mineral-tinged in the mouth with clean, pure fruits and floral notions, framed with juicy acidity and finishing long. Drink date: 2019-2026.



2017 FREEMAN CHARDONNAY RYO-FU (SONOMA COAST)

Robert Parker Wine Advocate Score: 90

Subdued on the nose, the 2017 Chardonnay Ryo-fu gives up soft pear and white fruits with touches of toast. It's medium-bodied, clean and fresh with toasty fruits and some nuttiness on the finish. Drink date: 2019-2023.
