


FREEMAN 2016 GLORIA ESTATE PINOT NOIR (GREEN VALLEY)

Wine Enthusiast Score: 96 Points (Cellar Selection)


This gorgeous wine shows an expressive wild-cherry aroma, a vibrant and pure black-cherry flavor and a firm, fine-grained texture for an enticing mouthfeel. Touches of mineral and iron in the aroma, and hints of rhubarb and forest floor in the flavor give it exciting breadth and complexity. Best after 2023.



FREEMAN 2016 YU-KI ESTATE PINOT NOIR (SONOMA COAST)

Wine Enthusiast Score: 95 Points (Cellar Selection)

A powerful, layered fruit character gives this medium- to full-bodied wine great focus, depth and length. Its core of black berry, currant and cherry is lightly accented by black tea and clove for an almost mysterious mix that is compelling to sip. A brisk texture of fine-grained tannins and nervy acidity completes this superbly balanced and well structured wine. Best from 2023.



FREEMAN 2016 AKIKO'S CUVÉE PINOT NOIR (SONOMA COAST)

Wine Enthusiast Score: 94 Points (Cellar Selection)

This is a vibrant, fruit-forward and firmly textured wine that offers fresh red- and black-cherry aromas accented by spice and earth. Medium to full in body, the wine has a luxurious mouthfeel and lingering finish. Considering its concentration and good structure, it will be best after 2023.



FREEMAN 2016 PINOT NOIR (RUSSIAN RIVER VALLEY)

Wine Enthusiast Score: 92 Points

Refined and elegant, this generously fruity wine is silky on the palate and brings red-cherry, rhubarb and raspberry notes that begin in the aroma and echo in the flavor. It is medium bodied, has subtle tannins and good acid balance.



FREEMAN 2016 PINOT NOIR (SONOMA COAST)

Wine Enthusiast Score: 92 Points

Fresh red-cherry and raspberry aromas are followed by elegant and complex fruit, baking-spice and rhubarb flavors that give this medium-bodied wine a lot to like. On the palate it's well balanced and almost delicate in mouthfeel.
